JULY 5, 2017

The Common Council of the City of Cumberland met on Wednesday, July 5, 2017, 7:00 P.M., at the Cumberland City Hall, 950 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue Ave. for their regular monthly meeting.

Mayor Skinner called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. The meeting was properly advertised and all interested parties were notified.

Motion by Slayton, second by Strickland, to approve a contract with Joshua Melstrom to perform the duties of the Building Inspector for a period of two years starting August 1, 2017. Motion

Motion by Goldsmith, second by Bents, to approve the award of the bid for sidewalk, curb and gutter on 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to Chippewa Concrete for \$27,260. Motion Carried.
