

MINUTES PARK AND RECREATION COMMITTEE MEETING
January 16, 2017
The Meeting was held at Cumberland City Hall

Chairman Laursen called the meeting to order at 8:00 am.

Motion was made by Schullo seconded by Bents to approve the minutes from the January 16, 2017 Parks & Rec Committee Meeting. Motion passed

Public Comment: None

The Committee heard a presentation from Larry Werner and Tia Duncan on plans they would like to implement for the coming summer on Library Lake. This is the outcome from the Place Making groups and CABA. The first goal is to have music along the lake using the Rutabaga stage on evening a week during the summer months. The second goal would be to get a wharf and docks along the area that was dredged last fall and a path to get boaters up to the downtown area from the lake. The third proposal will be to offer kayak rental on the lake using the schools kayaks. The Committee was very receptive to the ideas and will need to be kept informed of progress.

Hardie informed the Committee of the Eagle Scout project which Dylan Peterson is doing. Dylan plans to build 6 park benches for the City, It was suggested that a couple be placed along Library Lake and that they be cabled down so they don't end up in the lake.

The Committee considered a proposal to construct a Fish Cleaning House at Eagle Point Campground offered by the Mysicka Family in memory of Mayor Mysicka. The estimated cost of construction to be between \$2500 to \$3000 for the house. The Motion was made by Bents and seconded by Schullo to allow the family to build the fish cleaning house. The motion passed

Hardie updated the committee on the new online reservation system with the development date of February 23 and the new start date for reservations to be April 1.

The motion was made by Schullo and seconded by Bents, to adjourn at 9:13 am the motion passed.
