

MINUTES PARK AND RECREATION COMMITTEE MEETING

May 15, 2017

The Meeting was held at Cumberland City Hall

Chairman Laursen called the meeting to order at 8:00 am.

Motion was made by Schullo seconded by Strickland to approve the minutes from the April 17, 2017 Parks & Rec Committee Meeting. Motion passed

Public Comment: None

The Committee considered placing Vending machines at the Eagle Point Campground for the camping season. The motion was made by Strickland and seconded by Schullo to allow the vending machines at Eagle Point. The motion passed. Schwanke will make arrangements with Viking Coke in Rice Lake for the vending machines.

The Committee considered how to address the demand for long term (seasonal) reservations at the camp ground. The motion was made by Schullo and seconded by Strickland to grand-father Cook, Hansen and Faver, as seasonal campsites, with their camp sites to be placed back in standard rules once they give up their site and that all remaining site have a 30 day limit.

The Committee considered when to start taking reservations for the 2018 camping season. The motion was made by Schullo and seconded by Strickland to set the start date for the 2018 season at January 1, 2018

Hardie updated the committee on the parks. The street crew improved the Hines Lakeview boat landing. There will not be lifeguards this season. Hardie will order signs to be placed in the parking area stating No Life Guards on Duty and it was requested that an article be placed in the Advocated letting people know that there will not be lifeguards this summer
